This class is for Students who:

- were identified in the “at-risk” category, as measured by DIBELS®, DIBELS®Next, AIMSweb®, or Slingerland® Screening
- were identified as having a Reading Disability/Dyslexia by neuropsychological evaluation, standardized word attack and word identification measures
- have phoneme awareness-related decoding, fluency, &/or rapid naming deficits
- are or were eligible for an IEP and still are struggle in reading
- have not received instruction in reading
- are struggling English Language Learners
- have been identified for Tier 2 or Tier 3 intervention in an RTI program
- measures and shares student progress frequently

Our RAVE-O© small group classes:

- consist of 4-6 students, two staff members, and includes 93 sequential sessions
- tuition is \$7,125 for 93 lessons and includes 4 progress report meetings with parents
- are approximately 15 weeks long during the school year and 8 weeks in the summer
- meet 4-5 hours per week during the school year and 8-10 hours per week during the summer
- credit cards accepted
- tuition paid in four installments; due on Lessons numbers 1, 20, 40, & 60
- \$300 deposit required; full refund prior to *2 weeks before* the first class
- the deposit is credited to the student’s last invoice
